



## We are Still Collecting for Camp Noah!!

Chisago Lake Lutheran will be sending a team of 11 youth and adults to Houston this summer to help run Camp Noah for

kids that were affected by Hurricane Harvey last summer.

On Sunday, April 29<sup>th</sup>, our Sunday School Families assembled 37 Kids Kits for Camp Noah! Our goal is 50 kits, for one full camp! Every child at Camp Noah receives a kids kit to use and then take home at the end of camp, and we are looking for donations of the following items:

- 8 or 10-count broad line washable markers (classic colors)
- 8-count Crayola washable watercolor paints with brush
- 24-count Crayola Box of crayons
- Kids –sized blunted scissors
- Self-contained pencil sharpener

Kits will also contain a Black pen, Yellow pencil, Elmer’s Glue Stick and Playdough. We have enough of these items, but please help us out with the rest!

*Note: Fairness is very important to children, so we ask that you provide only Crayola brand markers, crayons, and watercolor paints, so that every Kids Kit is the same.*

**Donations can be dropped off in the tote in the Narthex. We will continue collecting, and have out Mission Trip Youth Assemble the rest in June.**
